

Private Equity and Venture Capital Investment in China: Issues for Practitioners

Before joining Mistral in 2016, Tianpeng had been a New York & China qualified lawyer for 13 years after 7 years’ legal study in China and in the U.S. Before moving to Ottawa, Mr. Wang was an equity partner of Jingtian & Gongcheng* for more than 5 years following 8 years as associate and senior associate at three international law firms of Clifford Chance, Morrison & Foerster and Linklaters and 9 months secondment to China Investment Corporation. His legal practice was mainly focused on advising international private equity firms, venture capital funds as well as multinational corporations investing in China as well as advising Chinese companies’ overseas investments, with industry coverage mainly focusing on healthcare, TMT, energy and financial services.
